

Internship Admissions, Support, and Initial Placement Data

Intern selection is made in accordance with all policies and practices of the Association of Psychology Postdoctoral and Internship Centers. The following required criteria are used to determine an applicant's match with the program. Each applicant must be from an APA accredited doctoral program in either clinical, counseling, or school psychology.

Specific Requirements:

- Combined **500** Hours of Intervention + Assessment
- At least **100** Hours of Therapy/Counseling Experience at the doctoral level (may include individual, group or family)
- At least **50** Hours of Child and Adolescent Therapy Experience
- Master's Degree Required
- Completion of all academic requirements of the doctoral program by the beginning of the internship.

Finally, while not required, we prefer applicants to have the following:

- Successfully proposed dissertation by internship start date
- A minimum of 15 integrated reports with children and adolescents
- Coursework and/or experience in family therapy
- Experience in multidisciplinary consultation
