The Children's Center is the oldest human services organization in Erie County. It was founded in 1871 by a group of women interested in helping orphaned and homeless children. Miss Sarah Reed was an original member of this group and served as its President for 45 years from 1889 until her death in 1934. Her contributions to the agency's early development were so substantial that in 1935 the Center was renamed in her honor.
